

Social Communication Assessments Reported Out At September 29 Morning PLC

The assessments listed in the table below were reported out by PLC attendees to have some utility for assessing social communication skills.

Name of Assessment	Report of Utility
CELF-5 Pragmatic Profile and Pragmatic Activities Checklist	Multiple PLC members reported that this assessment has provided them with useful information when assessing social communication skills. One PLC member noted that she appreciated the capability to observe students skills with this assessment.
CELF-IV	Many PLC members have used this. Some limitations were noted and those who are using the CELF-5 indicated that may be a better assessment if one can gain access to it.
TOPS (Tests of Problem Solving - ?3?	The version number of TOPS was not indicated, although TOPS 3 was found during a quick search after the PLC. The PLC members had mixed reviews. The original TOPS assessment was reported to be better than the revised version.
CASL (Comprehension of Spoken Language)	The PLC members reported that the CASL is old, but is soon to be revised.
Vineland-II	A rating scale assessment. The data is only as good as the accuracy of the reporter.
SSRS (Social Skills Rating Scale)	The documented comment from the PLC for this assessment was: "Eh."
Interval Peer Comparison Observation	Not a purchasable assessment, but useful.
Observation of Target Skill For Success Criteria	Not a purchasable assessment, but very useful.
